Length of the paper: up to 30.000 characters with spaces

Language: Serbian (Cyrillic script) and English

Text format: MS Word (.docx, .doc)

Font: Times New Roman

Page format: A4 (210×297mm)

Line spacing: single

Margins: left 2 cm, right 1,5 cm, top 2 cm, bottom 1,5 cm

Title of the paper: 12 pt., Bold, alignment centered, written in capital letters (Caps Lock)

The name and surname of the (co-)author(s): 11 pt., alignment centered, the author that will present the paper should be underlined, one line below the title

Institutions and E-mail addresses: 11 pt., *italic, alignment centered*, one line below the name(s)

Abstract: up to 300 words, 11 pt., alignment justified, one line below institutions and e-mails (if the paper is in Serbian language, the abstract must be written in both Serbian and English)

Keywords: up to 6 keywords, 11 pt., alignment justified

Text of the paper: 11 pt., alignment justified, with single spacing above and below the subtitles (subtitles in capital letters, bold)

References: 11 pt., enumerated in alphabetical order, at the end of the paper

Figure title: 11 pt., *italic, italic, centred below the figure*

Table title: 11 pt., *italic, centred above the table*

Referencing in the text: 9 pt., footnotes

Figures: eligible formats: TIF, GIF, JPG, BMP, WMF, CDR
